DECISION AND ORDER CLARIFYING BARGAINING UNIT

On October 27, 1980, this Board certified an election in which "no union" received a majority of the votes of the agricultural employees of Security Farms, the Employer herein. On December 28, 1982, the Employer filed a unit clarification petition, asking that certain of its employees, referred to as driver-stitcher-loaders, be included in the unit of agricultural employees certified on October 27, 1980.

In a report issued on March 7, 1983, the Regional Director for the Oxnard Region found that the driver-stitcher-loaders are engaged solely in activities incidental to farm work and are therefore agricultural employees under Labor Code section 1140.4(b) and 29 U.S. Code section 203(f). She therefore recommended that the driver-stitcher-loader employees be included in the unit certified on October 27, 1980. The Food Packers, Processors and Warehousemen's Union, Local 865 filed timely exceptions to the Regional Director's recommendation.

Pursuant to Labor Code section 1146, the Agricultural Labor Relations Board (Board) has delegated its authority in

this case to a three-member panel.

The Board has considered the record, and the attached Regional Director's recommendation, in light of the exceptions and briefs and has decided to adopt the Regional Director's recommendation.

ORDER

It is hereby ordered that the unit of all the agricultural employees of Security Farms is clarified to include any employees referred to as driver-stitcher-loaders.
