On September 10, 2009, the General Counsel of the Agricultural Labor Relations Board (ALRB or Board) submitted to the Board for approval a bilateral formal settlement agreement adjusting the charge in case number 06-CL-12-SAL. The General Counsel approved the settlement agreement on September 1, 2009. The General Counsel's cover memo to the Board was accompanied by the Regional Director's statement of reasons in support of the formal settlement agreement dated August 27, 2009. The formal settlement agreement was attached to the statement of reasons.

Upon reviewing the parties' signatures on the formal settlement agreement, the Board noted that the signature of the charging party, Leonel Carranza, was not dated, and the signature of the Respondent's representative was obtained on

December 17, 2007—a year and nine months prior to the approval of the settlement agreement by the General Counsel.

Considering the significant passage of time between the dates the parties' signatures were obtained and when the Regional Director submitted his statement of reasons in support of the settlement agreement, the Board seeks assurance that the settlement agreement still reflects the parties' wishes. The Board requests that the Salinas Regional Director submit a declaration concerning his knowledge of the date the signature of charging party Leonel Carranza was obtained. The Board also asks that the Regional Director provide a brief statement explaining the delay in submitting the settlement agreement for approval and an affirmation that the settlement agreement submitted to the Board on September 10, 2009 still accurately reflects the parties' wishes.
