PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Appeal From Orders Revoking Part

of UFW Notices in Lieu of Subpoena filed by Charging Party, United Farm Workers of America (UFW) on June 1, 2010 is hereby GRANTED in part.¹ The Board further limits the request contained in paragraph (a) of the UFW's Notice in Lieu of Subpoena as follows:

All correspondence, communications and exchanges of information relevant to compliance with the Board's order in case no. 93-CE-38-VIS (20 ALRB No. 13) between any agent or representative of any branch or office of the Agricultural Labor Relations Board (ALRB) on the one hand, and Respondent, its agents, lawyers or representatives on the other hand, and which was not copied to or served on the UFW.

¹ Pursuant to section 20242(b) of the Board's regulations, a party seeking interim review of a ruling by the executive secretary or the administrative law judge must file an application for special permission to appeal the ruling. The Board is treating the UFW's "Appeal From Orders Revoking Part of UFW Notices in Lieu of Subpoena" as such an application for special permission and grants the request.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the custodian of the records shall not be required to appear in person if Respondent provides copies of the requested records to the UFW by June 15, 2010, and certifies in writing that the response is fully responsive to the request. Prior to producing these records, Respondent may identify such documents to counsel for the UFW, who shall identify those already in his, or his client's possession. Any requests for an extension of time to comply with this order should be directed to the assigned administrative law judge.
