ORDER GRANTING GENERAL
COUNSEL’S REQUEST FOR
LEAVE TO SEEK COURT ORDER
REQUIRING COMPLIANCE WITH
SUBPOENAS DUCES TECUM

Admin. Order No. 2013-10

On January 10, 2013, the General Counsel of the Agricultural Labor
Relations Board (ALRB or Board) issued subpoenas duces tecum to the following ten

Respondent entities: Berenda Ranch LLC, Christopher G. Lagorio Trusts, Delta Pre-Pack Co. Kathleen Lagorio Janssen Trust, K.L.J. LLC, K.L. Janssen Living Trust, Lagorio Farming Co., Inc., Lagorio Farms, LLC, Lagorio Leasing Co., and Lagorio Properties LP, requiring the production of documents by January 24, 2013. None of these entities filed a petition to revoke the subpoenas. The General Counsel states that she has met and conferred with Counsel for these entities on January 30 and 31, 2013; however, no documents in response to the subpoenas have been produced.¹

On February 8, 2013, Counsel for the ten subpoenaed parties filed a Response to General Counsel's Request for Leave to Seek Court Order Requiring Compliance with Subpoenas Duces Tecum. The Response indicates that the subpoenaed parties are willing to produce the documents subject to a protective order which protects the privacy rights of the subpoenaed parties. The Response further indicated that if the parties are unable to reach agreement on the scope of a stipulated protective order, the subpoenaed parties do not object to the General Counsel's Request.

Also on February 8, 2013, Counsel for individuals Kathy Janssen and Dean Janssen filed a Response to General Counsel's Request for Leave to Seek Court Order Requiring Compliance with Notice to Appear. The Response indicates that the Janssens join in the response filed on behalf of the ten subpoenaed parties listed above.

¹ The parties were to have met and conferred again on February 8, 2013. To the Board's knowledge, no agreement has been reached
