On August 16, 2017, the Regional Director of the Salinas Region of the Agricultural Labor Relations Board filed with the Board a request for enforcement of the Board's decision and order in the above-captioned case, *Sabor Farms* (2016) 42 ALRB No. 2, and a supporting declaration. The request for enforcement alleges that, despite repeated requests, Respondent Sabor Farms ("Respondent") has failed to voluntarily comply with the Board's order. The Regional Director requests that the Board seek

 enforcement of its order pursuant to Labor Code section 1160.8<sup>1</sup>, which states in relevant part:

If the time for review of the board order has lapsed, and the person has not voluntarily complied with the board's order, the board may apply to the superior court in any county in which the unfair labor practice occurred or wherein such person resides or transacts business for enforcement of its order. If after hearing, the court determines that the order was issued pursuant to procedures established by the board and that the person refuses to comply with the order, the court shall enforce such order by writ of injunction or other proper process. The court shall not review the merits of the order.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT Respondent shall have until September 20, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. to file with the Executive Secretary of the Agricultural Labor Relations

Board a response to the request for enforcement. Any response shall be filed via facsimile transmission (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 8 § 20168, subd. (d)) or may be electronically filed (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 8 § 20169).
