On October 10, 2017, the Agricultural Labor Relations Board (“ALRB” or “Board”) issued a Decision and Order in *Premiere Raspberries, LLC* (2017) 43 ALRB No. 2 dismissing election objections filed by Premiere Raspberries, LLC (“Premiere”) in the above-captioned matter. On October 20, 2017, Premiere filed a Motion for Reconsideration of the Board’s Decision and Order.¹ The motion was filed pursuant to Board regulation² 20393, subdivision (c), which authorizes a party to a representation proceeding to request reconsideration of a Board decision or order because of

extraordinary circumstances. Prior to granting or denying a request for reconsideration, Board regulation 20393, subdivision (d) vests discretion in the Board to request a response from an opposing party and set a reasonable period within which to do so.

The Board hereby requests that the United Farm Workers of America (“UFW”) respond to Premiere Raspberries, LLC’s Motion for Reconsideration of Decision and Order no later than November 8, 2017. Pending a grant or denial of employer’s request for reconsideration, the Certification of Representative issued by the Board’s Executive Secretary on October 11, 2017, is hereby stayed.
