On January 10, 2018, the United Farm Workers of America (“UFW”) filed an unfair labor practice charge against Premiere Raspberries, LLC (“Premiere”) based on allegations that Premiere refused to bargain with the UFW. The General Counsel of the Agricultural Labor Relations Board (“ALRB” or “Board”) issued a complaint on the UFW’s unfair labor practice charge on February 9, and a consolidated complaint on May 7. Premiere answered the consolidated complaint on May 17. On July 3, the parties filed with the Board a stipulated set of facts and waived their rights to a hearing pursuant to Board regulation 20260.¹

The General Counsel also submitted a “Brief in Support of Joint Motion for Board Decision” concurrently with the stipulated set of facts. That brief is not part of the record stipulated to by the parties, however, the Board will accept it as the General Counsel’s brief pursuant to Board regulation 20260. The Board will consider briefs submitted by all parties before issuing a decision. The UFW and Premiere each may submit a brief to the Board no later than 20 days from the date of this order.
