ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On August 17, 2020, the General Counsel of the Agricultural Labor Relations Board (Board) filed with the Board a request for subpoena enforcement in the above-captioned matter along with a supporting declaration. The General Counsel requests that the Board authorize the filing of a superior court action pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 8, sections 20217, subdivision (g) and 20250, subdivision (k) to enforce a subpoena duces tecum served on respondent Coast King Packing, LLC. The General Counsel asserts that the subpoena was properly served on respondent, that respondent did not file a petition to revoke the subpoena, and that respondent did not provide complete responses to the subpoena.

The Board hereby ORDERS that respondent shall have until Wednesday, August 26, 2020 to file with the Board a response as to why the General Counsel's request should not be granted. Such response shall be supported by declaration(s) under penalty of perjury, as appropriate, and must be received by the Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the date indicated.
