ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On February 12, 2021, the General Counsel of the Agricultural Labor Relations Board (Board) filed with the Board a request for subpoena enforcement in the above-captioned matter along with a supporting declaration. The General Counsel requests that the Board authorize the filing of a superior court action pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 8, sections 20217, subdivision (g) and 20250, subdivision (k) to enforce a subpoena duces tecum served on respondent United Farm Workers of America on May 21, 2020. The General Counsel asserts that the subpoena was properly served on respondent, that the Board denied the respondent’s petition to revoke the subpoena on the merits (see *United Farm Workers of America (Flores Ramirez)* (Nov. 20, 2020) ALRB Admin. Order No. 2020-19), and that respondent has

not produced any documents or information responsive to the subpoena nor indicated whether it intends to respond to the subpoena.

The Board hereby ORDERS that respondent shall have until Thursday, February 25, 2021, to file with the Board a response as to why the General Counsel's request should not be granted. Such response shall be supported by declaration(s) under penalty of perjury, as appropriate, and must be received by the Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the date indicated.
