#### Petitions for Writ of Review of Unfair Labor Practice Decisions

#### California Appellate Courts

► Wonderful Orchards, LLC v. ALRB, Fifth District Court of Appeal, Case No. F081172

**Summary:** Petition for writ of review of the Board's decision in 46 ALRB No. 2, in which the Board found the employer unlawfully terminated a group of employees for engaging in protected concerted activity.

**Status:** The court issued an unpublished opinion on March 1, 2022, affirming the Board's decision. Any petition for review in the California Supreme Court is due April 11, 2022. A copy of the opinion is available at:

This report provides updates on legislative activity affecting the Agricultural Labor Relations Act or the Agricultural Labor Relations Board since the Board's February 22, 2022 meeting.

#### Senate Bill No. 1409 (Grove – R)

This bill was introduced on February 18, 2022. This bill proposes to repeal the Agricultural Labor Relations Act effective January 1, 2025, and directs the Board to submit a report to the Legislature by July 1, 2023, detailing a process for its abolishment. The bill further proposes to amend or replace the provisions of the Act to protect the associational rights of agricultural employees, ensure secret ballot elections are conducted for farmworkers to decide whether to have a union represent them, and to provide for the investigation, prosecution, and adjudication of unfair labor practices. Finally, the bill proposes to appropriate an amount of funds equal to the funds appropriated to the Board in 2022 for farmworker housing.
