

This report provides updates on legislative activity affecting the Agricultural Labor Relations Act or the Agricultural Labor Relations Board since the Board's June 15, 2022 meeting.

Assembly Bill No. 2183 (Stone – D)

This bill was introduced on February 15, 2022. The bill was approved by the Assembly on May 25 by a 49-22 vote and ordered to the Senate. On June 1, the bill was referred to the Committee on Labor, Public Employment and Retirement and the Committee on Judiciary. On June 22, the bill passed the Committee on Labor, Public Employment and Retirement on a 4-0 vote and was re-referred to the Committee on Judiciary, where it was heard on June 28 and passed on an 8-1 vote.

In its current form, the bill proposes a number of amendments to the Act, including (1) making an employer's employee list available to a labor organization upon a showing of 10% employee support; (2) authorizing the Board to assess civil penalties against employers who commit unfair labor practices; (3) requiring an employer post a bond as a condition to appealing any order involving an award of monetary relief; and (4) allowing a labor organization to be certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of a unit of employees upon the submission of representation cards signed by a majority of the employees without a secret ballot election.
