



1 This call will be arranged by the ALJ Unit of the ALRB. The participants will include  
2 the assigned ALJ, counsel for Respondent, counsel for the General Counsel, and any  
3 person or party (or their counsel or representative) who has attained intervenor status  
4 prior to the Prehearing Conference.  
5

6 PLEASE ALSO TAKE NOTICE of the obligations of the parties at the Prehearing  
7 Conference pursuant to Title 8, California Code of Regulations, section 20249, a copy of  
8 which is attached.  
9

10 If all of the parties agree that the Prehearing Conference is unnecessary, the  
11 Executive Secretary must be notified in writing on or before Friday, October 21, 2022.  
12 Generally, requests to cancel the Prehearing Conference are denied, and such requests  
13 will only be considered when the request is jointly made by all parties.  
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15 A party desiring that the Prehearing Conference be conducted in person, rather  
16 than by telephone conference call, must file with the Executive Secretary a written  
17 motion to that effect on or before Friday, October 21, 2022, indicating the reason(s) for  
18 the request. Such a motion must contain the position of the other party or parties  
19 concerning whether or not to have the Prehearing Conference call in person versus by  
20 telephone conference call.  
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24 **3. NOTICE OF CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

25 PLEASE ADDITIONALLY TAKE NOTICE that, pursuant to Title 8, California  
26 Code of Regulations, section 20262, a case management conference is hereby scheduled  
27 in the above-captioned matter.  
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1 At the case management conference, the ALJ and parties shall discuss the  
2 conduct and course of discovery, subpoenas, petitions to revoke, prospects for  
3 settlement, prehearing conferences, and the hearing.  
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5 The ALJ may require the parties to file a case management statement which  
6 discusses the status and scheduling of the matter, and any proposals or possible  
7 stipulations to streamline and/or expedite the case. The case management conference  
8 will be conducted by WebEx conference call on Monday, October 17, 2022, at 2:00 p.m.  
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10 **4. NOTICE OF POSSIBLE SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE**  
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12 PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that pursuant to Title 8, California Code of  
13 Regulations, sections 20248(a) & (b), and 20262(f), the assigned ALJ may direct that a  
14 settlement conference be held either at the prehearing conference or separately. Also, at  
15 any time after a complaint has issued, a party may request by email that a settlement  
16 conference be scheduled. Prior to the commencement of the settlement conference, a  
17 party may request that different ALJs be assigned to the prehearing conference and  
18 settlement conference.  
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21 **5. OTHER MATTERS**  
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23 Requests to continue the hearing for more than two days, or to change the hearing  
24 location, must be directed to the Executive Secretary. All other motions filed after the  
25 commencement of the case management conference are hereby assigned to the ALJ  
26 designated to hear the case.


