On June 9, 2025,<sup>1</sup> General Counsel filed with the Agricultural Labor Relations Board (Board) a request for special permission to appeal a June 3 ruling made by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Steven Wyllie denying the General Counsel's motion to hold the scheduled hearing virtually. Subsequently, on June 10, Respondent United Farm Workers of America (UFW) filed with the Board a request for special permission to appeal the ALJ's June 4 denial of UFW's motion to bifurcate the hearing.

To provide sufficient time for Board review of the parties' arguments, we issued an administrative order on June 13 postponing the hearing until July 8. (*UFW & Monterey Mushrooms, LLC* (2025) Administrative Order No. 2025-005). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the parties reached a settlement agreement. On June 30, the General Counsel filed a request to take the hearing off the calendar. On July 1, the Executive Secretary granted that request.

As the parties have agreed to a settlement, we find that the General Counsel and Respondent UFW's respective requests for special permission to appeal are now moot.

### **ORDER**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the General Counsel and Respondent UFW's requests for special permission to appeal are hereby DISMISSED as moot.
