On April 14, 2023, the General Counsel of the Agricultural Labor Relations Board (ALRB or Board) filed with the Board a request for leave to seek superior court enforcement of the Board’s order in *Lily’s Green Garden, Inc.* (2022) 48 ALRB No. 3 (enforcement request) pursuant to Labor Code section 1160.8 in this compliance case involving respondent Lily’s Green Garden, Inc. (Lily’s). Authority over compliance matters rests with the Board and the processing and litigation of disputed compliance matters is delegated to the regional directors. (Board regs. 20290-20292 (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 8, §§ 20290-20292); *Ace Tomato Co.* (May 13, 2014) ALRB Admin. Order No.

2014-07, p. 7.)¹ Accordingly, it is the Regional Director, rather than the General Counsel, who is the proper party to seek leave to enforce the Board's order in this matter.

The Board hereby directs the Regional Director of the Salinas Region to refile the enforcement request by 4:00 p.m. on May 8, 2023. Thereafter, Lily's shall show cause why the Regional Director's request for enforcement should not be granted. Lily's response must be received by the Board by 4:00 p.m. on May 11, 2023. (See Board reg. 20269, subd. (d).)
