- Chair Hassid reported on a recent decision involving Tri-Fanucci Farms, which included a request for the Regulatory Committee to review and recommend potential updates to rules governing unprofessional conduct during proceedings. The purpose is to ensure that administrative law judges (ALJs) and the Board have clear authority and appropriate tools, including sanctions, to maintain professionalism and uphold the integrity of hearings.

The committee is expected to provide recommendations in the coming months.

- Chair Hassid also highlighted participation in a Workers' Memorial Day conference hosted by the UC California Labor Lab in Sacramento. The conference focused on whether worker protections are keeping pace with current challenges. While discussions spanned multiple sectors, emphasis was placed on California's agricultural outreach efforts, including the California Worker Outreach Project and the Rural Strategic Engagement Program.
 - Upcoming Public Service Recognition Week will include events and communications recognizing the contributions of staff and the importance of public service across the agency and state government.
 - Chair Hassid announced a reception to be held on May 14 at a newer office in Santa Maria, staffed by the General Counsel's program and co-located with the Employment Development Department and the Santa Barbara County Farmworker Resource Center. Board members are invited to attend.
